

RMA S-25:

Discourage public officials from granting or requesting extensions to current ocean outfall legislation to ensure the timely closure (prior to 2025) of all treated wastewater outfall pipes and build/upgrade infrastructure for advanced water treatment and reuse to improve ocean water quality, reduce destructive algal blooms, and increase water reuse in the SEFCRI region.
