Quality Check For Listing Management Actions

Each Management Action:

- Is an activity that helps enhance or maintain the condition of coral reef ecosystems or reduce threats to coral reef ecosystems to ensure their long-term self-renewal.
- Is a short phrase: verb, object, and brief benefit of activity.



✓ ① List Management Actions

VERB

Install

OBJECT

a sufficient number of mooring
buoys in all high-use locations

BENEFIT

to reduce anchor damage to reefs.



① List Management Actions

VERB

Increase

OBJECT

tourism marketing in northern Florida

BENEFIT

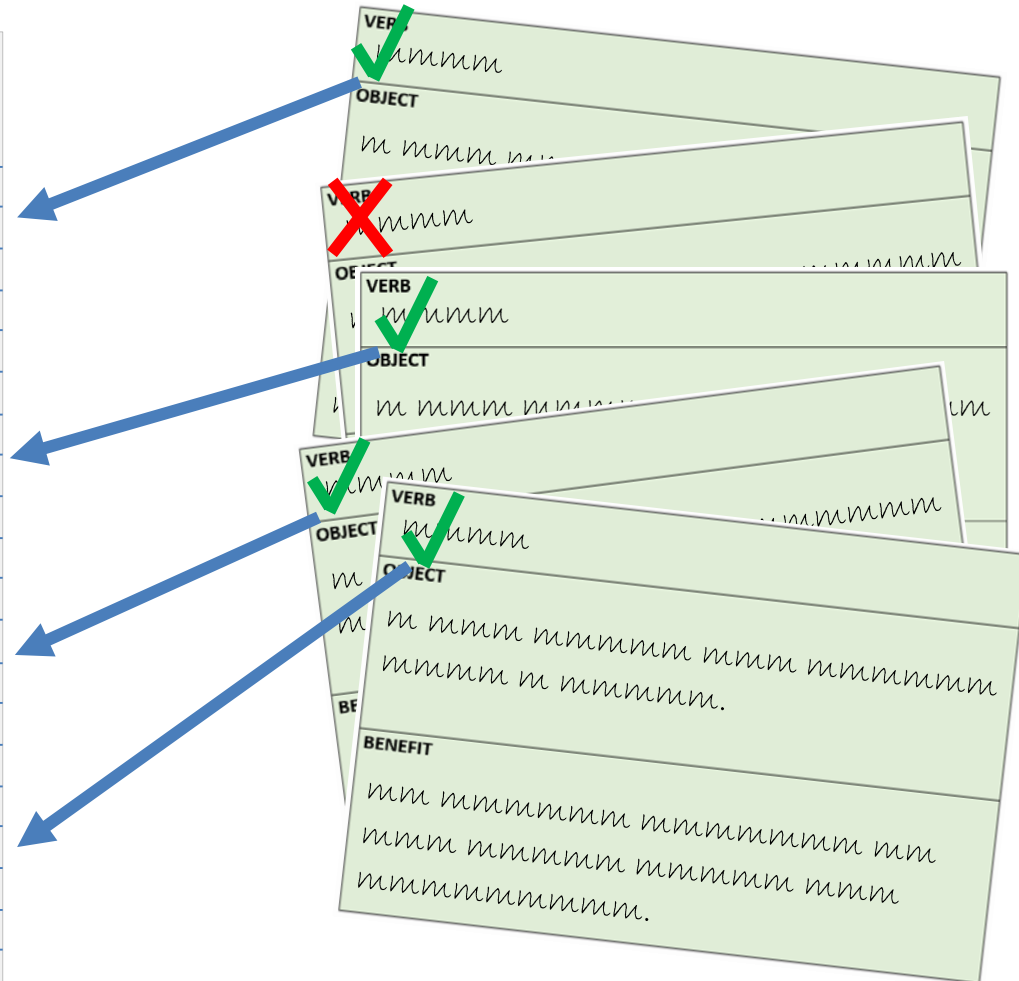
to divert visitors from southeast Florida, thereby reducing those impacts to the region's coral reefs that are associated with a higher population and more use.

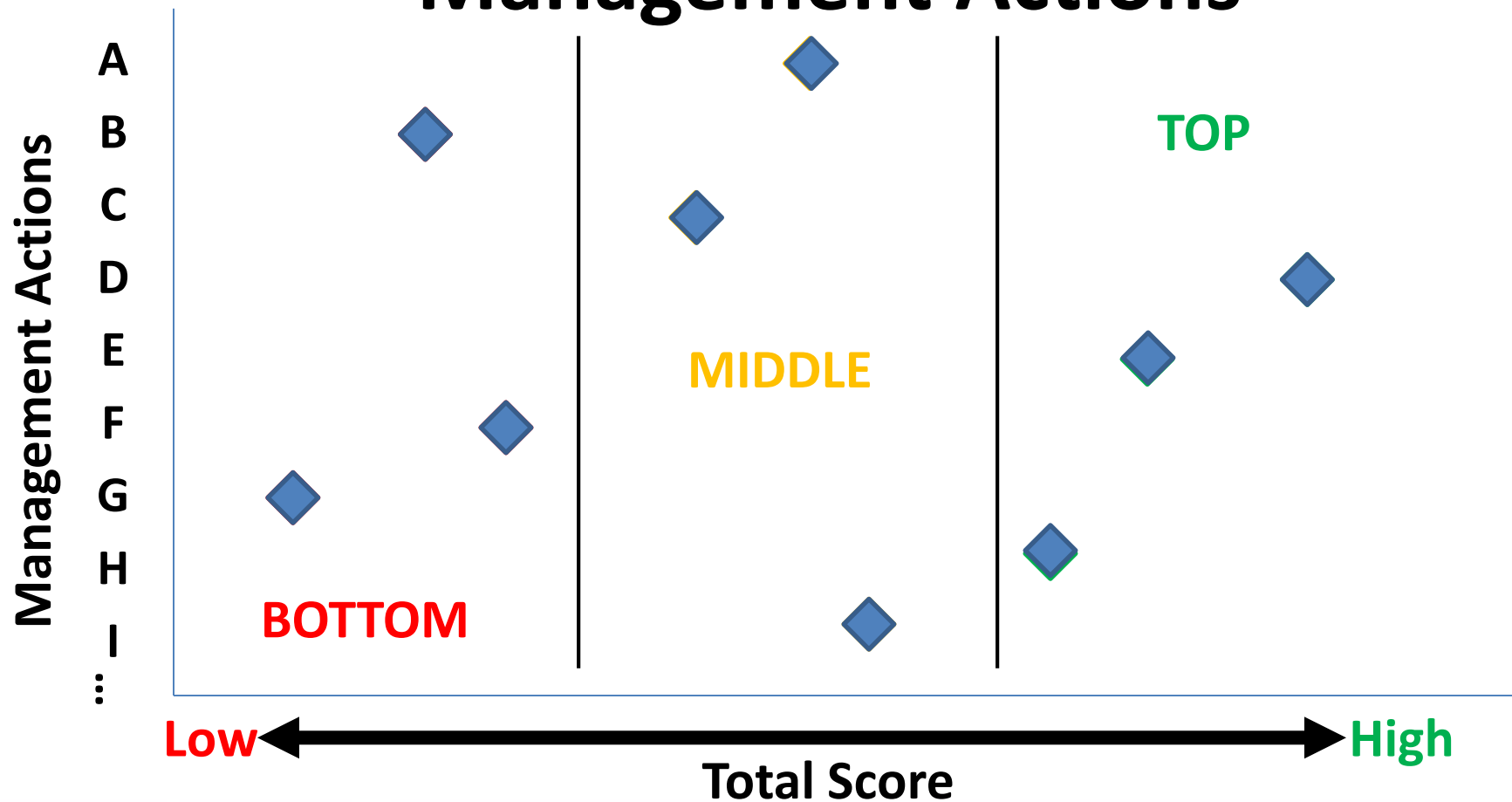

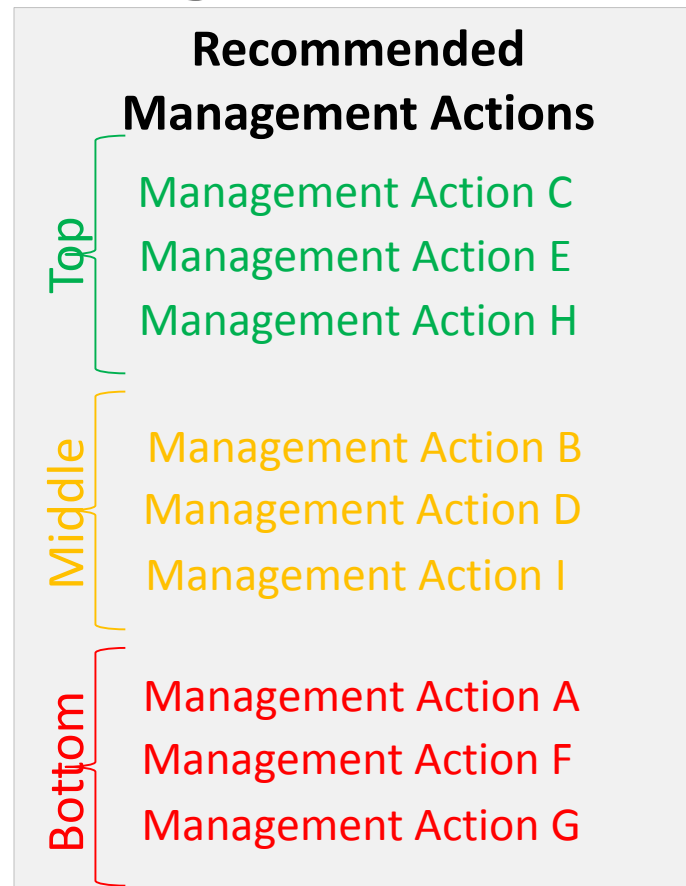

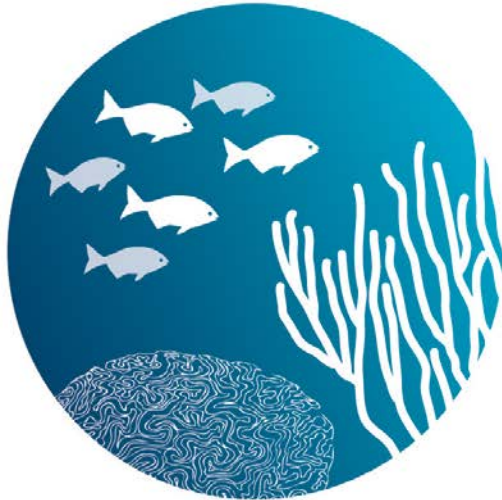
