Vision In Terms of the Environment

Vision In Terms of Community

Clear Spring is highly valued as a place for family reunions, weddings, and baptisms.

Smith County residents are proud that they use less water than in most other areas in the state.

Vision In Terms of Politics

There is broad consistent voter support for protection of Clear Spring.

Clear Spring is declared a National Natural Landmark.

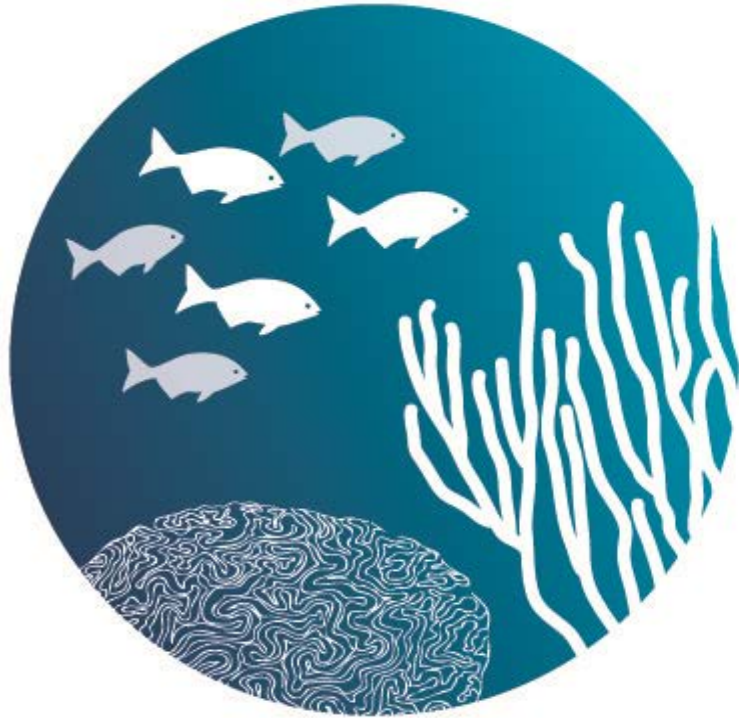
