<u>Title:</u> Support redefining the Port of Miami anchorage zone to remove four areas with reported coral from the existing anchor zone, reduce anchor damage currently being caused by ships anchoring zone which includes some coral reef.

Objective: The intended outcome of this action is to reduce anchor damage to existing coral reefs through the designation of a new commercial anchorage for the Port of Miami.

<u>Background</u>: This recommended management action is being put forth because there is currently a designated commercial anchorage over approximately 700 acres of coral reef within the Port Miami anchorage area.
