Title: Remove tires and debris from failed Broward County (Ft. Lauderdale and Deerfield Beach) (a.k.a. Osborne tire reef) artificial tire reef projects and the reef tract to eliminate damage to existing corals.

Objective: The intended outcome of this action is to eliminate impacts to reef resources by removing the approximately 700,000 tires from Broward County reefs and minimally remove the loose tires from the area adjacent to the reef edges.

Background: This recommended management action is being put forth because tires that were originally deposited offshore of Ft. Lauderdale and Deerfield Beach as part of an artificial reef project, have since become unbundled and are migrating onto the reef tract during high wave energy events.
